

Minutes of School Council 7th June 2011

- **Food consultation**- Mr Daly spoke at our last meeting to ask for pupil feedback on the provisions in a morning, break and lunchtime. The pupils raised the following points/suggestions at today's meeting:
 - **A Meal deal should be available consisting of a sandwich/salad/soup with a drink and a piece of fruit/yoghurt for a reduced price**
 - **Concern was raised that pupils on free school meals cannot buy a full meal, dessert and drink and cannot purchase food at break so may be hungry until 1.15pm**
 - **Free or very cheap fruit should be available**
 - **One sachet of sauce should be given for free but only if the canteen staff are asked to save waste and mess**
 - **Better bacon should be used on the bacon butties-less fat to save waste/mess left on tables**
 - **Sometimes there is too much salt in the soup but not any given for chips!!**
 - **Cereal boxes and milk should be available in the morning for breakfast as many pupils do not eat anything until break**
 - **Staff should wear uniforms, hairnets and badges with their name (MRS)** this might mean they are treated with more respect
